<p>***The opened area reported has an environmental license*** The property Fazenda Bonanza has an authorization for clearing 395 hectares of native vegetation issued in September 2022 by the Environmental Agency in Mato Grosso (SEMA - MT) valid until August 2025 (1). There are 6 court cases between Milton Carlos Zolin and ADM and an ongoing case between Ibama and Milton Carlos Zolin (initiated in May 2022) (2). He was the founder and president of Sindicato Rural de Porto dos Gaúchos (Sindporto), which is part of the Federação da Agricultura e Pecuária de Mato Grosso (FAMATO) (3). Milton Carlos Zolin has also 1 active loan from the BNDES (Brazilian Development Bank) of BRL 249,00 contracted in 2020 in Porto dos Gaúchos (MT) (4).</p>
