


General comments

Agropecuária Santa Barbara Xinguara (Agro SB) was allegedly the number one deforester in Brazil in 2017. The company is the (co-) owner of all six Fazendas Lagoa do Triunfo farms I, II, III, IV, V, VI (1, 2), totalling 145,000 ha (3). There is continuous deforestation and fire in the Lagoa do Triunfo farms. For instance, on August 17, 2019, NASA detected fires on Fazenda Lagoa do Triunfo IV, covering 273 ha of native vegetation clearance between July and August 2019 (4). Next to cattle production, the company is active in soy and corn production (2). AgroSB is owned by the Opportunity Fund – run by Daniel Valente Dantas, a banker with a long track record of felonies and crimes against Brazil's financial system. In addition to Fazenda Lagoa do Triunfo, AgroSB owns three other farms in Pará: Vale Sereno, in Cumaru, do Norte; São Roberto, in Santana, do Araguaia; and Espírito Santo, in Xinguara (5). Dantas was arrested in 2008 for trying to bribe public servants and was accused of being the leader of a criminal organization linked to money laundering and tax evasion (6). In 2009, the Brazilian Justice froze all of Dantas' agribusiness holdings, including 27 farms – totalizing 500,000 hectares – and 453,000 cows, for illegal money laundering (7). In 2017, AgroSB's Fazenda Vale Sereno, in Cumaru do Norte, Pará, received fines totalizing BRL 77.4 million. In 2018 the same farm was again listed in Ibama's list of deforesters. AgroSB is also linked to other issues in Pará, including land conflicts and the accusation of using pesticides as a chemical weapon (8), past allegations of slave labour (9) and being involved in the disappearance of a worker (10). In 2018, landless workers occupied Dantas' lands in Complexo Cedro, in Marabá, Pará (11). The company was denounced by Comissão Pastoral da Terra (CPT) for hiring private security firms with no permission to operate in the State of Pará. These firms were founded by a former policeman and were considered a way of creating an appearance of legality for militia groups (12). An investigation from Repórter Brasil, The Guardian and the Bureau of Investigative Journalism shows that AgroSB raises cattle in areas embargoed by Ibama inside the Lagoa do Triunfo farms (13). Animals from this specific farm were transferred for fattening on Fazenda Espírito Santo, which directly supplied JBS, Minerva, Frigol, Marfrig and Frigorífico Valêncio. The Selo Verde database, created by the Environmental Agency of Pará, mentions a total deforestation of 2,580 hectares after 2008 in the property Lagoa do Triunfo IV (14). Between 2011 and 2017, the Brazilian Development Bank (BNDES) authorized 96 loans to Agropecuária Santa Bárbara Xinguara (15).
