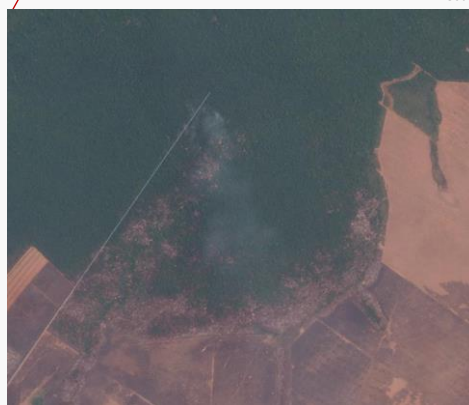

<p>Luis Alberto Donin was involved in the murdering of 3 people in Matupá in 1990 (known as the "Chacina de Matupá"). He was initially sentenced for the triple homicide in 2011, but the decision was cancelled in 2021 due to lack of evidence (1). He owned a gas station in Matupá (MT) which is no longer active (2). The CAR declaration of Fazenda São Joaquim I (Peixoto de Azevedo - MT) is under analysis and was declared by Luis Alberto Donin and Paulo Cesar Donin (3).</p>
