<p>The property has valid authorization for the clearance of native vegetation. The property is linked to Santa Colomba Cafés, a coffee, cotton, cocoa, and soy-producing company certified by UTZ (since 2006) and Rainforest Alliance (since 2007) (1). A linked company, Kendon Real Estate, is mentioned in the Panamá Papers data (2) but has been inactive since 2020 (3). In 2021, Santa Colomba Cafés obtained authorization for the deforestation of an area of 4,900 hectares in the farms Fazendas Rio do Meio 01, Rio do Meio 03, Canguçu 04, and Canguçu 05, valid for four years (4).</p>
