General comments

In March 2022, José Ademir Toniazzo received authorization for the clearance of 472 hectares of native vegetation at Fazenda Rancho Alegre, which is valid until March 2024 (1). Anderson Toniazzi, a relative of José Ademir Toniazzo, is one of the directors of the APRUP, Association of Rural Producers of Pratudão River, which is active in the agribusiness sector of West Bahia (2). Other Toniazzo family members are also part of AIBA, the Association of Irrigation in Bahia (3), and ABAPA, the Association of Cotton Producers (4). In July 2023, José Ademir Toniazzo and other members of the Toniazzo family benefited from a court decision that gave them the land rights of more than 400,000 hectares, an area previously occupied by 342 small farmers in Correntina, in Bahia (5, 6).
