

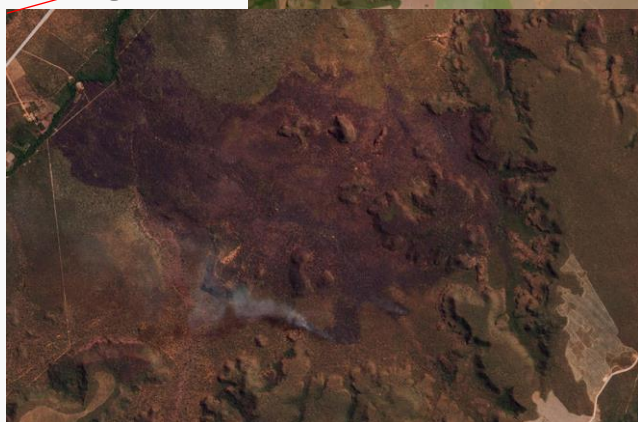

General comments				
Fazenda São Gabriel and Fazenda Colheres, which are part of Ipê Agroindustrial and Fazenda Ipê, were already part of case studies included in the RDM reports 4 and 7, from August 2022 and November 2022 respectively (1) (2). Ricardo Faria bought the company InSolo in November 2021, becoming Brazil's 5th largest crop producer with more than 120,000 hectares of crop cultivation (mainly soy) (3). InSolo was the centre of the scandal involving Harvard University's endowment fund. The company was linked to a series of social and environmental impacts in Piauí, which was reported by Chain Reaction Research (4), Grain (5), and Rede (6). Fazenda Ipê is also involved in a case of land grabbing (7). InSolo had soy trading links to Bunge and Cargill (8, 9).
